| Description | <p>Demonstrate the blender warm-up:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shoulders over hips over heels 2. Move left shoulder back while moving right shoulder forward as a blender blade works 3. Start moving the lower body to match the shoulder movements 4. OPTIONAL MOVEMENT: Slowly bend knees slightly to stop and then slowly stand up |
